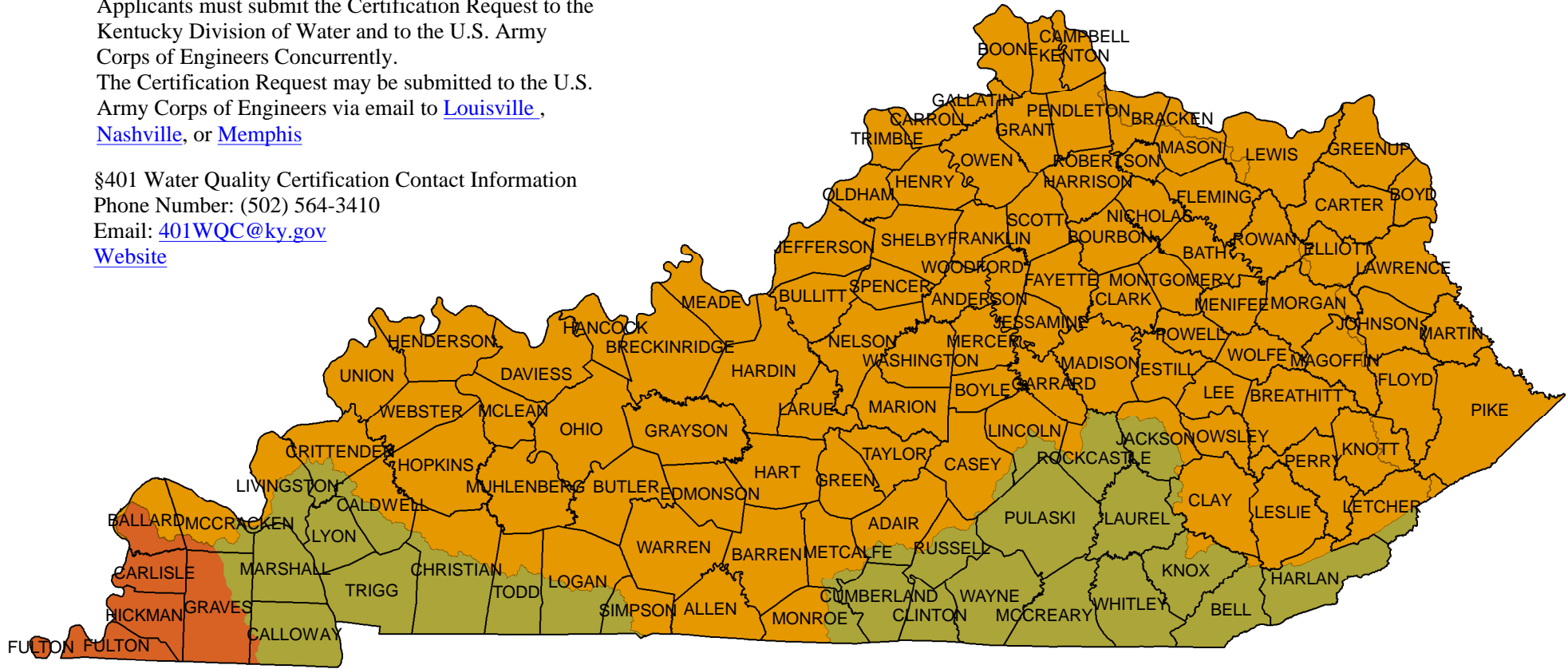


United States Army Corps of Engineers District Boundaries in Kentucky
