Kentucky DMS – Serious Accident No.1

On Wednesday March 24, 2021, a 64-year-old surface miner with 7 years of mining experience was seriously injured while working at a surface mine in the Pikeville Branch.

The accident occurred while the victim was retrieving a sample from the top of the fire clay coal seam, near the base of a wall of shot rock. The victim received blunt force trauma type injuries when struck by debris (loose material) that fell from the wall.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1. Pre-shift examinations of all work areas shall be conducted by a certified foreman and recorded in the record book for that purpose prior to the conducting of work.
- 2. Hard hats shall be worn at all times when in active works.
- 3. Sampling shall only be conducted in areas where the wall has been taken down to a safe height prior to sampling.
- 4. No equipment will be operated within 100 feet from a sampling location while persons are present at the sampling location.
